1. What nation is the Bald Eagle a symbol of?

Answer: USA

2. When fully grown, how wide is the wing span?

Answer: 8 ft.

3. Why is the Bald Eagle called bald?

Answer: Because it has white feathers on top of its head

4. What do bald eagles eat?

Answer: Mostly fish, but also small rodents and small snakes

5. How far can a bald eagle see?

Answer: 1-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ (one to one and a half) miles

6. How fast can they dive?

Answer: 100 mph

8. Try this experiment:

To see how an eagle flies, get a piece of paper and hold it to your chin. Blow over the strip of paper. The paper should fly up into the air. This demonstrates how air blowing above the wing can help an eagle fly. Blow air faster and the paper should go higher. The faster the air goes over the paper (or wings) the more it goes. This is called lift. When the amount of lift is more than the weight of the eagle, the bird will float up into the air.
