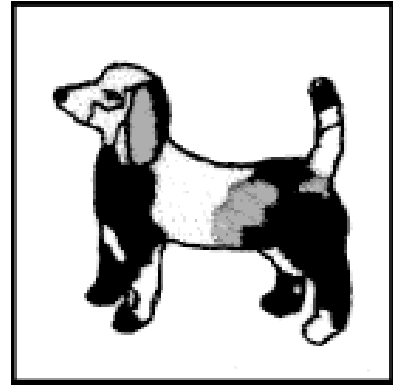


DOG PETS



1. Identify the parts of the dog: Body, Head, Tail, Paws, Neck, Legs.
2. Tell at least 3 things that a dog needs to eat and drink.
3. Draw, color, or build a doghouse, or a doggy bed for the pet's shelter.
4. Show how to hold the dog's leash, and tell why you must not jerk hard.
5. Draw, color, or show how to hold a puppy or small dog safely.
6. Show or tell how to care for the dog with a comb.
7. Give a small dog or puppy a bath, and dry the animal properly.
8. Tell or show the basic commands: "sit," "sit-stay," and "come".
9. Tell why a puppy or small dog is your responsibility, and why you must remember to take good care of your friend.
10. Visit a veterinarian (dog doctor), a dog kennel, or a dog training school.
11. Care for a dog for 1 month. (ex. a neighbor's dog.)
