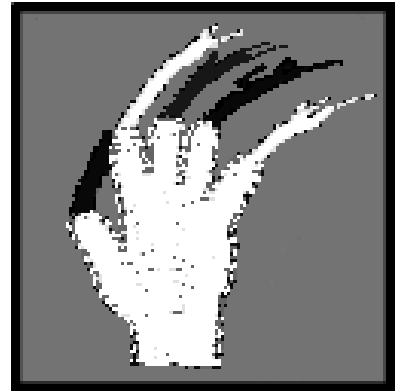


FINGER PAINTING

1. What are finger paints mixed with?
2. How can you make finger paints. If you cannot buy them ready made?
3. What kind of paper do you use and why?
4. What are the “primary” colors? Make sample.
5. What do you get by mixing blue and yellow? Make sample.
6. What do you get by mixing blue and red? Make sample.
7. What do you get by mixing red and yellow? Make sample.
8. Paint with one color 3 different “strokes” (vertical, horizontal, curves).
9. Paint with two colors a nature object (flower, butterfly, tree, etc.).
10. Paint a picture of your own choice.



HELPS:

2. Mix wallpaper paste and water to a creamy smooth consistency and add dry or moist poster paints.
3. Use glossy, smooth paper (glazed finger painting paper is available in craft shops). “Smooth” craft or wrapping paper can be used for try outs. Wet surface with a sponge before painting so paints will “glide” on easier. Porous paper will absorb paints (not good).
4. Red, Yellow, Blue
5. Green
6. Purple
7. Orange
