Opossum

They like to live near water, they are good climbers. They can hang upside down by their tails. They are awake and hunt for food at night (nocturnal). They eat grass, eggs, fruit and insects. They "play dead" when frightened.

Porcupine

Porcupines have sharp claws that help them climb. Their sharp teeth help them eat bark and leaves of trees. They also have hairs called quills under their fur. They used the quills to stop animals who are trying to hurt them.
