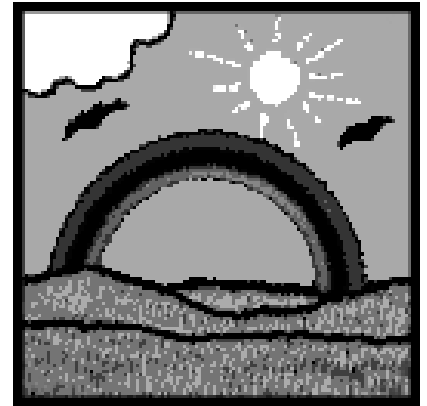


GOD'S SKY
