HELPS:

1. 13 types of plastic material, mainly ABS (acrylonitrile butadiene styrene)
2. Billund, Denmark
3. Over 1 billion
4. From the Danish words "leg godt", meaning "play well". The word "Lego" also means "I assemble" or "I put together" in Latin.
5. Town, Space, Castle, and Pirates.
6. Bricks are 3 times the size of plates. Therefore, it takes 3 plates to equal 1 brick.
