



MINIATURE VEHICLES

1. Make a collection of 15 small cars, trucks, etc.
2. Learn who made your vehicles and where they were made.
3. Draw a “board” for them to drive and park on.
4. Have a “box” garage to store them in when not in use.
5. Tell your group which is your favorite.
6. Tell the group which was the first one you collected.
7. Display your collection at a club meeting or youth fair.

HELPS:

1. Encourage the child to collect at least 15 different items but may be collected as a group project with each child taking one item home at end of award.
2. Find manufacturer name and place where they were made.
3. You may wish to do this as a class project, individual or with a buddy. Make the area at least 16"x20", draw, color and finish it then spend time playing with the collection.
4. This may be a simple home made “garage” box or basket or a store bought container if they already have this item.
5. Give each Adventurer time to share their favorite encouraging public speaking within their group.
6. The first in the collection may have a special significance.
7. Give the children an opportunity to share collection and work with parents, families, church and community friends.
