Answer: A tablet bearing the date of the Declaration of Independence
7. Name the national bird.
Answer: The bald eagle
8. Is the bald eagle bald? Describe or draw a bald eagle.
Answer: No. It looks bald because its head is covered with white feathers.
9. What is the name of the bell in Pennsylvania?
Answer: The Liberty Bell
10. Name the statue that overlooks the Reflective Pool in Washington D.C.
Answer: Lincoln Memorial
11. Mount Rush more is a national memorial carved on the Black Hills of South Dakota.
12. List the order from left to right of the faces that appear on the mountain.
Answer: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Franklin Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln

13. What is the shape of the Washing Monument?

Answer: Obelisks of Ancient Egypt somewhat like a pyramid.
