



PIN/BUTTON

1. Collect at least (15) pin type buttons.
2. In this collection have at least four (4) different round sizes.
3. Collect at least four (4) different shapes.
4. Include six (6) religious buttons in your collection
5. Have a trading time and trade at least three (3) buttons with other Adventurers
6. Learn to play fair and share if you have extra
7. Mount your pin/button collection neatly on a cloth back ground.
8. Display your collection at a club meeting or youth fair.
9. When were pin/buttons first used?
10. Share with the club how and when you obtained your first pin/button and where it came from.



HELPS:

The aim is to enjoy and neatly display your collection, and to learn to share with others and to fairly trade pin/buttons. Variety is more important than large numbers.

Collect different shapes, colors, and sizes of buttons.

These button pins are to be inexpensive campaign-type buttons pins, not the more costly stud-type button/pins as made for AJY pins.

You may wish to borrow a "button machine" and make an individual button for each child to add to their collection - one of their own creation or a picture of each child with name and date.
