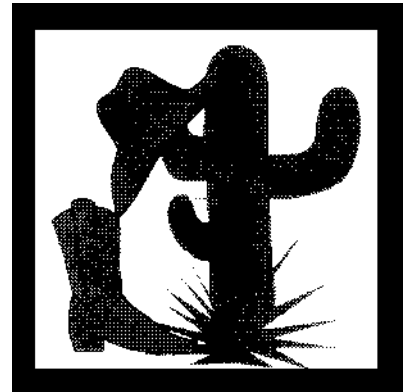




WILD WEST
