- 1. What materials are bottle made of?
- 2. a. Collect ten (10) bottles.
 - b. Make sure there are at least five (5) different shapes.
 - c. Make sure there are at least two (2) different colors.
 - d. Make sure they're clean, by washing them with warm, soapy water and letting them dry.
- 3. Name at least three (3) things bottles can be used for.
- 4. Go to a store with an adult and fins at least five (5) things that can be purchased in a bottle. Make a list.
- 5. Be a good inspector--Look at each bottle.
 - a. What color is it?
 - b. Does it have a date on it?
 - c. What is printed or engraved on it?
 - d. Is there anything else anywhere on the bottle?
- 6. Decorate two bottles (either inside or outside).



Helps:

- 1. Usually glass or plastic.
- 3. Decoration, storage, flower arrangements, store toys, preserve food, storing or showing collections, etc.
- 4. Milk, juice, salad dressing, medicine, candy, baby bottles, water, etc.
- 6. Suggestion: paint the outside or fill the inside with something.
