

CAT PETS

- 1. Identify the parts of the cat: Body, Head, Tail, Paws, Neck, Legs.
- 2. Tell at least 3 things that a cat needs to eat and drink.
- 3. Draw, color, or make a cat's house or a cat's bed.
- 4. Show how to pick up and safely hold a cat or draw and color an example.
- 5. Tell why you can pick up a kitten by its neck fur (nape).
- 6. Show or tell how to care for the cat with a cat comb or brush.
- 7. With an adult, give a cat a dry bath, a wet bath, or a dry shampoo.
- 8. Collect at least 5 different pictures of cats.
- 9. Visit a veterinarian (animal doctor), a cattery, or a cat show.
- 10. Tell why it is not a good idea to feed a cat or kitten "chicken bones".
- 11. Care for a cat for one month. (may be a eighbor's cat)
