



MINIATURE TOYS

1. Make a collection of miniature figurines.
2. Learn, if you can, where your collection was first enjoyed and how long ago.
3. Arrange your collection so others may see and enjoy.
4. Have a sharing time when each child may tell about two of their favorite items and when they collected them.
5. Teach children to care for their toys and where to keep them.



HELPS:

1. These need not be expensive items, but small toys are fine.
2. Look up and share about their collection.
3. Display neatly showing the children how to be creative.
4. Allow each child equal time to share their collection.
5. Teach child to keep collection up and away from smaller siblings and visitors that may swallow them or break them and to take good care of their display.

It is OK to not share collection with friends to play with, but the child shouldn't play with the miniatures when others are present if they are unwilling to share.
