EVERY FAMILY MATTERS



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EVERY FAMILY MATTERS ... REGARDLESS

While the Church spends about 40 hours a year with kids and teens, Parents spend about 3000 hours a year with those same kids and teens.

Every Family Matters, regardless.

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Why Do Parents Matter?

Every parent matters because they matter to God. **Every parent matters because** they matter to their kid. **Every parent matters because** their kids matter to them. What happens at **HOME** is more important than what happens at Church. No one has more potential to influence a kid than a parent. A parent isn't the only influence that a kid needs. Truth ... If parents don't think your church matters. you will have a hard time influencing their family.

Families outside the church don't TRUST us. Families outside the church don't BELIEVE us. Families outside the church don't GET us. Families outside the church don't NEED us. Consider this ... Your church has one of two perspectives. It's their problem. It's our mission. We won't change the way families outside the church see us until we change the way we see them.

Two Truths ... **Every parent** wants to be a good parent. **Every parent** can do something more. Kids need A NEW Kind of Leader Who will ... **CONNECT** with a PARENT. Every parent needs ... To have an ally, so they don't feel alone To know what to do today, so they have a plan. To see how they are winning, so they have hope.

A New Kind of Leader will keep showing up weekly because they know it's the best way to open a door for a kid's future.
You have the potential to open a door for a child.
 It's not about what you can do, it's about what God can do through you.
 It's not your job to change them, it's your responsibility to love them.

Some things take time. Some things take repetition. Some things can't be accomplished in a week ... This week matters even when you don't think it matters. WHAT you do this week **Matters More** When You DO IT EVERY WEEK. Kids need A NEW Kind of Leader Who will ... **KEEP SHOWING UP.**

You can show up to help a kid do at least four things:

- Hear from God by navigating the Bible, listening to stories of faith, and personalizing Scripture.
- Pray to God together and learn to pray personally and privately for the needs of others.



- 3) Talk about God with friends and other adults who trust.
- 4) Live for God through giving, service, praise, and obedience.
