


## AREA CAMPOREE 2025 BAPTISM INFORMATION

## **BAPTISM AT AREA CAMPOREE**

Any Pathfinder (or adult) who wants to be baptized at their Area Camporee will need to have the following people "sign off."





✓ Parent/Legal Guardian

Each of the above individuals should work through the Club Director to make sure all these adults are in agreement for the child to be baptized.

If your child has made plans to be baptized during Area Camporee, we want you/your family to be present! If you are already registered for Area Camporee, you are all set; if not, you may still attend IF you complete the following requirements by the Monday of the week your Area Camporee begins.

- Confirm that the parent(s), pastor, and director have cleared the baptismal candidate.

Please cc your Club Director and Pastor in the email you send us / so we know that the Director knows that you are planning to attend an Area Camporee.



We will share this list of names with our Area Camporee Security Team.



We will ask for photo IDs for all those 18+ years old; to confirm names on our list with adults entering. Please have a government-issued ID ready.



We will ask for a mobile phone number also, in case we need to contact you.



We will ask you to sign in upon arrival and sign out when you leave (by 2:00 pm on Sabbath).



When you arrive, those on the list you emailed us will be allowed to enter AC with a special wristband at no cost, for the times listed below.



We will give you complimentary access to Area Camporee from the hours of 11:00 am – 2:00 pm on Sabbath. This will allow you time to be present for the baptism and enjoy lunch with your child/club. Make this arrangement in advance with your club OR purchase in advance a lunch ticket, if available.
