

RED ZONE – 2026 - PARKING / VEHICLE INFORMATION

PARKING – There are two main general parking areas (no permit/pass needed). To PARK at a Building or Campsite requires a Parking Permit. To enter camp to unload requires a Camp Access Pass. Parking Permits/Camp Access Passes are available in YMMS. This is managed by the Club Director – who gets Parking Permits or Access Passes.

Long-Term – vehicles park here for the weekend; vehicles may exit/enter Long-Term parking area all weekend (no pass/permit needed to enter/exit Long-Term Parking; all guests must have the RZ wristband to enter camp)

Short-Term – where vehicles **temporarily** park to exchange a CAMP ACCESS PASS; and where vehicles **temporarily** wait to drop off registered children into the care of adult staff from their club. No overnight parking.

PARKING PERMIT – These vehicles are allowed to PARK, in Campsite or Building (if purchased), and should NOT be driven around camp until Sunday 9:30 am. These PERMITS must be “purchased” (free) in YMMS, by the Club Director/Secretary, in YMMS, and sent to the Driver of the Vehicle authorized to Park at the Campsite / Building.

This YMMS Parking Permit TICKET MUST be presented at Check In to EXCHANGE it for the actual paper PERMIT. Our Check In Team will scan the YMMS Parking Permit Ticket (can be scanned only once) and give the vehicle a printed paper Parking Permit. The Printed Paper Parking Permit is the only way these vehicles ENTER Camp. Vehicles with the Parking Permit must leave the Permit displayed on their dashboard. It may not be exchanged.

No YMMS Parking Permit Ticket = No Parking Permit (No Parking Permit, that Vehicle NOT allowed to enter Camp).

There are **ONLY TWO OPTIONS** for Parking Permits: **Campsite** and **Building** Permits.

CAMPSITE Parking Permit – Each Club is allowed ONE vehicle to PARK in their Campsite for the weekend. This Vehicle must have the Campsite Parking Permit displayed in the dashboard of the vehicle.

BUILDING Parking Permit – Each Club that purchased Housing from Camp is allowed to have TWO vehicles park, each with a Building Parking Permit, per building purchased. This allows parking in front of the housing they bought.

CAMP ACCESS PASS – Allows a Vehicle ACCESS ONLY to Enter/Unload/Exit – this is NOT a Parking Permit.

CAMP ACCESS PASS (CAP) – These vehicles are allowed to ENTER/UNLOAD/EXIT. Each Club will receive two CAP's. CAP's are “purchased” (free) in YMMS by the Club Director/Secretary, who will send the YMMS CAP Ticket to the Driver of the Vehicles arriving FIRST. The Driver of the vehicle will present the CAP YMMS Ticket at Check In and receive a PRINTED CAMP ACCESS PASS (CAP). When the vehicle with the CAP exits camp, they exchange the CAP with another vehicle from their Club in the Short-Term Parking Area. For other vehicles from your Club to be able to Enter/Unload/Exit, the Vehicle with the CAP must exchange the CAP with the next vehicle from your club.

The Camp Access Pass has ONE purpose – to help Clubs Enter/Unload/Exit. It is NOT a PARKING PERMIT.

Clubs with **OVER 50 people registered** to attend Red Zone, will receive **ONE additional Camp Access Pass**.

Clubs with **OVER 100 people registered** to attend Red Zone, will receive **TWO additional Camp Access Passes**.

Clubs may exchange these passes as many times as needed to allow other vehicles from the same club to ENTER/UNLOAD/EXIT. The Camp Access Pass expires on Friday, 10:00 pm. No cars will be allowed to enter after that. All vehicles will be sent to Long Term Parking and must haul / transport their gear on foot to their campsite on their own, if arriving after 10:00 pm on Friday. Plan accordingly.

When a vehicle with the CAP is Unloading – they must be PARKED INSIDE the Clubs Marked Campsite to keep the road clear for vehicles to drive around / get through to their campsite. Thank you for your cooperation.

DROP OFFS

If **anyone** in a Vehicle is NOT REGISTERED for RZ, the Vehicle will NOT be allowed to Enter Camp (even if somehow, they have a Permit/Pass). The Vehicle will be sent to Short-Term Parking, to Drop Off all Registered/Banded Guests and their gear. Adults must accompany minors. Please do NOT leave children unattended.
